

ORDINANCE NO. 170

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ARLINGTON, IOWA TITLE VI-
PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT, CHAPTER 4 UTILITIES-REFUSE COLLECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Arlington, Iowa
that the following section be changed in the Municipal Code:

6-4-6. Schedule of Fees: The monthly fee for solid waste collection and disposal
services are:

Rates shall increase 3% each year on July 1st commencing on January 2022.

Payment of Bills. All fees are due and payable under the same terms and conditions
provided for payment for water service as contained in 6-5-4 of this Code of Ordinances,
and the provisions contained in relating to notices of delinquency and lien notices shall
also apply in the event of delinquent fees for solid waste collection.

SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be
adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such shall not affect the validity of any section or
part not declared invalid or unconstitutional.

WHEN EFFECTIVE. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after July 1, 2021
and publication as provided by law.
